### ORDINANCE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:

SECTION 1. The City Council finds that the area described in Section 2 of this ordinance is adversely affected by the over-concentration of businesses licensed to sell alcoholic liquor within and near the area.

SECTION 2. Section 4-60-022 of the Municipal Code of Chicago is hereby amended by inserting the underscored language as a new subsection 4-60-022 (3.45) through 4-60-022(3.47), as follows:

4-60-022 Restrictions On Additional Licenses.

Subject to the provisions of subsection 4-60-021 (c), no additional license shall be issued for the sale of alcoholic liquor, for consumption on the premises within the following areas:

*(Omitted text is unaffected by this ordinance)*

- 45) On State Street, from 18<sup>th</sup> Street to Cullerton Avenue.
- 46) On State Street, from Cullerton Avenue to Cermak Road.
- 47) On State Street, from Cermak Road to Adlai E. Stevenson Expressway (I-55).

*(Omitted text is unaffected by this ordinance)*

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication.
