ORDINANCE THE BENTLEY TAVERN
 Acct. No. 229746 - 1 Permit No. 1107998

Be It Ordained by the City Council of the City of Chicago:

Permission and authority are hereby given and granted to THE BENTLEY TAVERN upon the terms and subject to the conditions of this ordinance, to maintain and use a portion of the public right of way for a sidewalk cafe adjacent to its premises located at 2834 N. Southport Ave.. Said sidewalk cafe area #1 shall be twenty-one point three three (21.33) feet in length and nine (9) feet in width, area #2 shall be thirteen point four two (13.42) feet in length and five point seven five (5.75) feet in width, area #3 shall be eleven point two five (11.25) feet in length and five point seven five (5.75) feet in width, area #4 shall be eight (8) feet in length and five point seven five (5.75) feet in width, area #5 shall be nine (9) feet in length and five point seven five (5.75) feet in width, area #6 shall be fourteen (14) feet in length and five point seven five (5.75) feet in width for a total of five hundred twelve point zero seven (512.07) square feet and shall allow six (6) feet of clear space from the face of the curb/building line along N. Southport Avenue, W. Wolfram. The compensation for said space and the days and hours of operation for the sidewalk cafe shall be as follows:

Monday through Thursday 5:00 p.m. to 11:00 p.m. Friday 5:00 p.m. to 12:00 midnight Saturday 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 midnight Sunday 9:00 a.m. until 10:00 p.m. Compensation: \$600.00 SEATING CAPACITY: 48

Sidewalk Cafe Permit and approved plan must be posted at all times.

This grant of privilege #1107998 for a sidewalk cafe shall be subject to the provisions of Section 10-28-800 though 10-28-885 of the Municipal Code of Chicago and the directions of the Commissioner of Department of Business Affairs and Consumer Protection, the Commissioner of Streets and Sanitation, and the Commissioner of Transportation.

The permit holder agrees to hold the City of Chicago harmless for any damage, relocation or replacement

costs associated with damage, relocation or removal of private property caused by the City performing work in the public way.

Authority for the above named privilege is herein given and granted from and after March 1, 2013 through and including December 1, 2013.
