ORDINANCE BYLINE BANK Acct. No. 398078
- 7 Permit No. 1123674

Be It Ordained by the City Council of the City of Chicago:

SECTION 1. Permission and authority are hereby given and granted to BYLINE BANK, upon the terms and subject to the conditions of this ordinance to maintain and use two (2) sign(s) projecting over the public right-of-way attached to its premises known as 1600 W. Chicago Ave..

Said sign structure(s) measures as follows; along W. Chicago Avenue:
One (1) at seven point seven five (7.75) feet in length, three (3) feet in height and sixteen point three three (16.33) feet above grade level.

Said sign structure(s) measures as follows; along N. Ashland Avenue:
One (1) at eight point nine two (8.92) feet in length, two (2) feet in height and fourteen point eight three (14.83) feet above grade level.

The location of said privilege shall be as shown on prints kept on file with the Department of Business Affairs and Consumer Protection and the Office of the City Clerk.

Said privilege shall be constructed in accordance with plans and specifications approved by the Department of Transportation (Division of Project Development) and Zoning Department - Signs.

This grant of privilege in the public way shall be subject to the provisions of Section 10-28-015 and all other required provisions of the Municipal Code of Chicago.

The grantee shall pay to the City of Chicago as compensation for the privilege #1123674 herein granted the sum of one hundred seventy-five (\$175.00) per annum in advance.

A 25% penalty will be added for payments received after due date.

The permit holder agrees to hold the City of Chicago harmless for any damage, relocation or replacement costs associated with damage, relocation or removal of private property caused by the City performing work in the public way.

Authority herein given and granted for a period of five (5) years from and after Date of Passage.

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GENERAL NOTES

1. All design fabrication installation and construction shall conform to that following applicable codes and specifications on the drawing. The Chicago Building Code, the American Institute of Steel Construction, Inc. Manual of Steel Construction (13th Edition), American Wire Society ANSI/AWS D1.1 and AISI Structural Welding Code - Steel or Aluminum Association Specification for Structural Steel Buildings (15th Edition).
2. All components shall be as manufactured unless noted otherwise. All "As Shown" dimensions shall be as shown on the drawing. All dimensions shall be in feet and inches, rounded to the nearest 1/8".
3. All steel shall be A36 steel or equivalent. All bolts shall be A325 bolts or equivalent. All nuts shall be A325 nuts or equivalent. All washers shall be A325 washers or equivalent. All anchors shall be A307 anchors or equivalent. All fasteners shall be galvanized steel or equivalent. All fasteners shall be installed in accordance with the manufacturer's instructions. ATTACHMENT LOCATIONS SHALL BE SPACED EQUALLY WASHERS SHALL BE USED AT EACH FASTENER - FULLY

WHERE THE WALL MATERIAL IS FITS OR ANOTHER COMPRESSIBLE MATERIAL, WOOD SPACERS SHALL BE USED AROUND EACH FASTENER BETWEEN THE BACK OF THE RACEWAY OR LETTER AND FRONT OF THE BRACKEN OR RIGID WALL MATERIAL.

MATERIAL NOTE: THE CHAMFEL LETTERS AND LOGO CABINET SHALL HAVE 1/8" ALUMINUM ANGLE 0.090" ALUMINUM RETURN. THE RACEWAYS SHALL BE A 8"W FORKED BOX CC 0123 ALUMINUM SHEET. EACH LETTER SHALL BE SECURED TO THE RACEWAY WITH A MINIMUM OF THREE 1/4" SELF-DRILLING SCREWS. THE LOGO CABINET SHALL BE SECURED TO THE RACEWAY WITH A MINIMUM OF SIX 1/4" SELF-DRILLING SCREWS. SCREWS SHALL BE SPACED EQUALLY.
