ORDINANCE

WHEREAS, Santa Maria Addolorata Church has permanently closed, and therefore no longer has function for Church service parking; now therefore

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:

SECTION 1. That Ordinance 2016-5902, which previously passed on September 14, 2016, and was published on page 31442 of the Journal of the Proceedings for that date, be stricken to facilitate removal of the signs, as follows:

West Ohio Street; West Ohio Street (south side) from a point <10 foot east of North Ada Street to a point-08 foot east thereof; Two Hour Parking, 7:00am to 3:00pm, Sundays Only (16 05627736) [03016 6002]

SECTION 2. That Ordinance 2020 -1884, which previously passed on January 27, 2021, and was published on page 26788 of the Journal of the Proceedings for that date, be stricken to facilitate removal of the signs, as follows:

West Ohio Street (south side), from a point 30 foot west of North Ada Street to a point 115 feet west thereof two-hour parking-7:00 A.M.-3:00 P.M.-sunday (20- 02940338) (incorrect proposal not 2 percent parking).

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall be in force and take effect from and after its passage and approval.
