BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:

SECTION 1. That the Commissioner of Transportation is hereby authorized and directed to repeal 1 Hour Parking Restriction signs at the below listed locations:

WARD MISCELLENEOUS:

23 S. Major Avenue; Repeal One Hour Parking, S. Major Avenue from Archer Avenue to a point 100 feet south thereof (east side only) by striking the above [02013-9475]
