ORDINANCE COLUMBUS
FOOD Acct. No. 85479 - 4
Permit No. 1097253

Be It Ordained by the City Council of the City of Chicago:

SECTION 1. Permission and authority are hereby given and granted to COLUMBUS FOOD, upon the terms and subject to the conditions of this ordinance to maintain and use, as now constructed, one (1) Occupation of Space(s) on the public right-of-way adjacent to its premises known as 800-832 N. Troy St..

Said Occupation of Space(s) at N. Troy Street measure(s):

One (1) at four hundred sixty-six point nine one (466.91) feet in length, and fifty (50) feet in width for a total of twenty-three thousand three hundred forty-five point five (23345.5) square feet. Existing occupation of space is used for improve security and to reduce crime such as vandalism and theft.

The location of said privilege shall be as shown on prints kept on file with the Department of Business Affairs and Consumer Protection and the Office of the City Clerk.

Said privilege shall be constructed in accordance with plans and specifications approved by the Department of Planning and Development and Department of Transportation (Division of Project Development).

This grant of privilege in the public way shall be subject to the provisions of Section 10-28-015 and all other required provisions of the Municipal Code of Chicago.

The grantee shall pay to the City of Chicago as compensation for the privilege #1097253 herein granted the sum of eleven thousand seven hundred forty-seven (\$11,747.00) per annum in advance.

A 25% penalty will be added for payments received after due date.

The permit holder agrees to hold the City of Chicago harmless for any damage, relocation or replacement costs associated with damage, relocation or removal of private property caused by the City performing work in the public way.

Authority herein given and granted for a period of five (5) years from and after Date of Passage.
