ORDINANCE
REHABILITATION INSTITUTE OF CHICAGO Acct.
No. 6323 - 5 Permit No. 1106180

Be It Ordained by the City Council of the City of Chicago:

SECTION 1. Permission and authority are hereby given and granted to REHABILITATION INSTITUTE OF CHICAGO, upon the terms and subject to the conditions of this ordinance to construct, install, maintain and use four (4) Earth Retention System(s) under the public right-of-way adjacent to its premises known as 630 N. McClurg Ct..

Said Earth Retention System(s) at 300-350 E. Erie Street measure(s):
One (1) at one hundred twenty-one point one seven (121.17) feet in length, and two point seven five (2.75) feet in width for a total of three hundred thirty-three point two two (333.22) square feet.

Said Earth Retention System(s) at 350-400 E. Erie Street measure(s):
One (1) at one hundred forty-six point one seven (146.17) feet in length, and two point eight three (2.83) feet in width for a total of four hundred thirteen point six six (413.66) square feet.

Said Earth Retention System(s) at 630 N. McClurg Court measure(s):
One (1) at two hundred twenty-four point zero eight (224.08) feet in length, and two point five (2.5) feet in width for a total of five hundred sixty point two (560.2) square feet.

Said Earth Retention System(s) at 300-400 E. Ontario Street measure(s):
One (1) at three hundred ten point zero eight (310.08) feet in length, and two point nine two (2.92) feet in width for a total of nine hundred five point four three (905.43) square feet.

Said earth retention systems shall be installed at plus ten point three (10.3) CCD below grade to top of sheet pile. The bottom of sheet pile will be installed to a depth of minus eighty (80) CCD.

The location of said privilege shall be as shown on prints kept on file with the Department of Business Affairs and Consumer Protection and the Office of the City Clerk.

Said privilege shall be constructed in accordance with plans and specifications approved by the Department of Transportation (Office of Underground Coordination).

This grant of privilege in the public way shall be subject to the provisions of Section 10-28-015 and all other required provisions of the Municipal Code of Chicago.

The grantee shall pay to the City of Chicago as compensation for the privilege #1106180 herein granted the sum of one thousand six hundred (\$1,600.00) per annum in advance.

A 25% penalty will be added for payments received after due date.

The permit holder agrees to hold the City of Chicago harmless for any damage, relocation or replacement costs associated with damage, relocation or removal of private property caused by the City performing work in the public way.

Authority herein given and granted for a period of five (5) years from the Date of Passage.
