BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:

SECTION 1. Pursuant to Title 9, Chapter 64, Section 160, of the Municipal Code of Chicago, the following locations are hereby designated as Loading Zones for the distances specified, during the hours specified:

WARD LOADING ZONES / STANDING ZONES:

WARD REPEAL LOADING ZONES / STANDING ZONES:

27 Repeal No parking, loading zone from 325 South Paulina Street, Monday through Friday, by Striking 8:00am to 4:00pm and inserting 7:00am to 6:00pm in lieu thereof. [02020-4236]
