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ORDINANCE  
CHICAGO BOARD OF TRADE OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO, INC. Acct.  
No. 8472 - 1 Permit No 1124131

*Be It Ordained by the City Council of the City of Chicago:*

SECTION 1. Permission and authority are hereby given and granted to CHICAGO BOARD OF TRADE OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO, INC., upon the terms and subject to the conditions of this ordinance to maintain and use, as now constructed, nine (9) Concrete Wall(s) on the public right-of-way adjacent to its premises known as 141 W. Jackson Blvd..

Said Concrete Wall(s) at S. Financial Place measure(s):

One (1) at five (5) feet in length, and one point three (1.3) foot in width for a total of six point five (6.5) square feet. Existing concrete wall is approximately two (2) feet in height.

Eight (8) at ten point one five (10.15) feet in length, and one point three (1.3) foot in width for a total of one hundred five point five six (105.56) square feet. Existing concrete walls are approximately three (3) feet in height.

The location of said privilege shall be as shown on prints kept on file with the Department of Business Affairs and Consumer Protection and the Office of the City Clerk.

Said privilege shall be constructed in accordance with plans and specifications approved by the Department of Planning and Development, Department of Transportation (Division of Project Development), and Department of Transportation (Office of Underground Coordination).

This grant of privilege in the public way shall be subject to the provisions of Section 10-28-015 and all other required provisions of the Municipal Code of Chicago.

The grantee shall pay to the City of Chicago as compensation for the privilege #1124131 herein granted the sum of five thousand nine hundred seventy-six (\$5,976.00) per annum in advance.

A 25% penalty will be added for payments received after due date.

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The permit holder agrees to hold the City of Chicago harmless for any damage, relocation or replacement costs associated with damage, relocation or removal of private property caused by the City performing work in the public way.

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
