BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO.

SECTION 1. Title 17 of the Municipal Code of Chicago, the Chicago Zoning Ordinance, is hereby amended by changing all of the RS-3 Residential Single-Unit District symbols and indications as shown on Map No. 7-J in the area bounded by

A line 66.11 feet North of and parallel to West Altgeld Street; the Alley next east of and parallel to North Spaulding Avenue; a line 34.86 feet North of and parallel to West Altgeld Street; and north Spaulding Avenue.
