SECTION 1. Pursuant to Title 9, Chapter 64, Section 090, of the Municipal Code of Chicago, portions of the below named streets are hereby designated as Residential Permit Parking Zones, for the following locations:

WARD REPEAL RESIDENTIAL PERMIT PARKING ZONES:

19 South Washtenaw Avenue; Repeal Ordinance which reads: South Washtenaw Avenue to West 102nd Street to West 103rd (east side); Residential Parking Permit Zone 1457, All Times, All Days, by Striking the Above [02020-3507]
