MISCELLANEOUS SIGNS RESERVED

DISABLED PARKING

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:

SECTION 1. That the Commissioner of Transportation is hereby authorized and directed to repeal Reserved Disabled Parking signs at the below listed locations:

WARD MISCELLENEOUS:

- 25 1900-1908 W. Cermak Road: Repeal ordinance which establishes W. Cermak Road (north side) from a point 26 feet west of S. Wolcott Avenue to a point 50 feet west thereof; 2% Disabled Parking by striking the above - (13-01198565) [O2013-3039]
- 42 330 N. Wabash Avenue: Repeal ordinance which establishes 330 N. Wabash Avenue (adjacent to), 2% Public Disabled Parking by striking the above [O2013-3136]

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force here in after its passage and publication.
