ORDINANCE

■ BUSY BEES CHILD DEVELOPMENT CENTER Acct.

No. 362835 - 1 Permit No.. 1100939

Be It Ordained by the City Council of the City of Chicago:

SECTION 1. Permission and authority are hereby given and granted to BUSY BEES CHILD DEVELOPMENT CENTER, upon the terms and subject to the conditions of this ordinance to construct, install, maintain and use five (5) Awning(s) projecting over the public right-of-way adjacent to its premises known as 3155 S. Shields Ave..

Said Awning(s) at S. Shields Avenue measure(s):

Three (3) at eleven (11) feet in length, and two (2) feet in width for a total of sixty-six (66) square feet. Two (2) at eight point six seven (8.67) feet in length, and two (2) feet in width for a total of thirty-four point six eight (34.68) square feet.

The location of said privilege shall be as shown on prints kept on file with the Department of Business Affairs and Consumer Protection and the Office of the City Clerk.

Said privilege shall be constructed in accordance with plans and specifications approved by the Zoning Department - Signs.

This grant of privilege in the public way shall be subject to the provisions of Section 10-28-015 and all other required provisions of the Municipal Code of Chicago.

The grantee shall pay to the City of Chicago as compensation for the privilege #1100939 herein granted the sum of one hundred (\$100.00) per annum in advance.

A 25% penalty will be added for payments received after due date.


