ORDINANCE
RUNNING AWAY MULTISPORT Acct. No.
215610-4 Permit No. 1101858

Be It Ordained by the City Council of the City of Chicago:

SECTION 1. Permission and authority are hereby given and granted to RUNNING AWAY MULTISPORT, upon the terms and subject to the conditions of this ordinance to construct, install, maintain and use three(3) Awning(s) projecting over the public right-of-way adjacent to its premises known as 2219-21 N. Clybourn Ave .

Said Awning(s) at N. Clybourn measure(s):

One (1) at twenty-five point five (25.5) feet in length, and two point five (2.5) feet in width for a total of sixty-three point seven five (63.75) square feet.

One (1) at six point eight (6.8) feet in length, and two point five (2.5) feet in width for a total of seventeen (17) square feet.

One (1) at fifteen point six (15.6) feet in length, and two point five (2.5) feet in width for a total of thirty-nine (39) square feet.

The location of said privilege shall be as shown on prints kept on file with the Department of Business Affairs and Consumer Protection and the Office of the City Clerk.

Said privilege shall be constructed in accordance with plans and specifications approved by the Zoning Department - Signs.

This grant of privilege in the public way shall be subject to the provisions of Section 10-28-015 and all other required provisions of the Municipal Code of Chicago.

The grantee shall pay to the City of Chicago as compensation for the privilege #1101858 herein granted the sum of one hundred fifty dollars and fifty cents (\$150.50) per annum in advance.

A 25% penalty will be added for payments received after due date.

The permit holder agrees to hold the City of Chicago harmless for any damage, relocation or replacement costs associated with damage, relocation or removal of private property caused by the City performing work in the public way.

Authority herein given and granted for a period of five (5) years from and after Date of Passage.
