LOADING ZONES

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:

SECTION 1. Pursuant to Title 9, Chapter 64, Section 160, of the Municipal Code of Chicago, the following locations are hereby designated as loading zones for the distances specified, during the hours specified:

WARD LOADING ZONES:

- 1 W. Chicago Avenue (south side) from a point 87 feet north of N. Hoyne Avenue to a point 20 feet north thereof: No Parking Loading Zone, 10:00 AM to Midnight, Monday through Saturday/Tow Zone - 12-01411280 [02012-5506]
- 2 W Adams Street (north side) from a point 30 feet south of S. Racine Avenue to a point 76 feet south thereof: 15 Minute Standing Zone, must use flashing lights -12-01105042 [02012-3978]
- 15 W. 65th Street (north side) from a point 50 feet west of S. California Avenue to a point 20 feet west thereof: No Parking Disabled Loading Zone at all times (public benefit) - 12-01349014 [02012-4501]
- 25 S. Carpenter Street (west side) from a point 20 feet south of W. Polk Street to a point 20 feet south thereof: 15 Minute Loading Zone, use flashing lights, Tow Zone after 15 minutes, 10:00 AM to 8:00 PM, Monday through Sunday - 12-01414034 [02012-5077]
- 26 N. Kimball Avenue (west side) from a point 30 feet north of W. Fullerton Avenue to a point 20 feet north thereof; 15 Minute Loading Zone, must use flashing lights/ Tow Zone after 15

- 47 W. Lawrence Avenue (south side) from a point 90 feet west of N. Clark Street to a point 20 feet west thereof: No Parking Loading Zone, 9:00 AM to 10:00 PM / Tow Zone-12-01418359 [02012-5073]
- 49 N Greenview Avenue (east side) from a point 20 feet north of W. Greenleaf Avenue to a point 40 feet north thereof: 15 Minute Standing Zone, use flashing lights/ Tow Zone after 15 Minutes, 7:00 AM to 6:00 PM, Monday through Friday -12-01418326 [02012-5496]

- 13 Repeal ordinance passed June 30th, 2009, journal page 65605 which reads: S. Pulaski Road (west side) from a point 47 feet south of W. 60th Street to a point 122 feet south thereof: 15 Minute Standing Zone by striking the above and adding: S. Pulaski Road (west side) from a point 47 feet south of W. 60th Street to a point 108 feet south thereof: 15 Minute Standing Zone, must use flashing lights - 12-01348963 [02012-4781]
