ORDINANCE

SEB IMMIBILIEN INVESTMENT GMBH Acct.

No. 322757 - 1 Permit No. 1104068

Be It Ordained by the City Council of the City of Chicago:

SECTION 1. Permission and authority are hereby given and granted to SEB IMMIBILIEN INVESTMENT GMBH, upon the terms and subject to the conditions of this ordinance to maintain and use, as now constructed, two (2) Flag Pole(s) on the public right-of-way adjacent to its premises known as 550 W. Adams St..

Said Flag Pole(s) at W. Adams measure(s):

Two (2) at point eight (.8) feet in length, and point eight (.8) feet in width for a total of one point two eight (1.28) square feet.

The location of said privilege shall be as shown on prints kept on file with the Department of Business Affairs and Consumer Protection and the Office of the City Clerk.

Said privilege shall be constructed in accordance with plans and specifications approved by the Department of Transportation (Division of Project Development).

This grant of privilege in the public way shall be subject to the provisions of Section 10-28-015 and all other required provisions of the Municipal Code of Chicago.

The grantee shall pay to the City of Chicago as compensation for the privilege #1104068 herein granted the sum of one hundred fifty (\$150.00) per annum in advance.

A 25% penalty will be added for payments received after due date. Page 1
