ORDINANCE
ILLINOIS INSTITUTE OF TECHNOLOGY Acct. No.
63395 - 8 Permit No. 1104717

Be It Ordained by the City Council of the City of Chicago:

SECTION 1. Permission and authority are hereby given and granted to ILLINOIS INSTITUTE OF TECHNOLOGY, upon the terms and subject to the conditions of this ordinance to maintain and use, as now constructed, one (1) Duct under the public right-of-way adjacent to its premises known as 3100-3400 S. State St..

Said Duct(s) at East 31st Street measure(s):

An existing eight (8) inch concrete duct running under and across East 31st Street at a point eighty (80) feet east of the east line of South State Street, as widened, thence entering private property located at 12 East 31 street. Existing duct shall be eight (8) inches in width, sixty-six (66) feet in length for a total of thirty-nine (39) and six-tenths (39.6) square feet used for electrical service.

The location of said privilege shall be as shown on prints kept on file with the Department of Business Affairs and Consumer Protection and the Office of the City Clerk.

Said privilege shall be constructed in accordance with plans and specifications approved by the Department of Transportation (Division of Project Development) and Department of Transportation (Office of Underground Coordination).

This grant of privilege in the public way shall be subject to the provisions of Section 10-28-015 and all other required provisions of the Municipal Code of Chicago.

The grantee shall pay to the City of Chicago as compensation for the privilege #1104717 herein granted the sum of four hundred (\$400.00) per annum in advance.

A 25% penalty will be added for payments received after due date.

The permit holder agrees to hold the City of Chicago harmless for any damage, relocation or replacement costs associated with damage, relocation or removal of private property caused by the City performing work in the public way.
