## City Council March 13, 2013

## ORDINANCE

## BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:

SECTION 1. Section 4-60-022 of the Municipal Code of Chicago is hereby amended by deleting the language struck through, as follows:

#### 4-60-022 Restrictions on additional licenses.

Subject to the provisions of subsection 4-60-021 (c), no additional license shall be issued for the sale of alcoholic liquor, for consumption on the premises within the following areas:

#### (Omitted text is unaffected by this ordinance)

(36.16) On West Fullerton Avenue, from North Central Park Avenue to North Hamlin Avenue, and on the north side of West Fullerton Avenue, from North Hamlin Avenue to North Avers.

(Omitted text is unaffected by this ordinance)

SECTION 2. Section 4-60-023 of the Municipal Code of Chicago is hereby amended by deleting the language struck through as follows:

## 4-60-023 Restrictions on additional licenses.

Subject to the provisions of subsection 4-60-021 (c), no additional package goods license shall be issued for any premises located within the following areas:

#### (Omitted text is unaffected by this ordinance)

(35.16) On West Fullerton Avenue, from North Central Park Avenue to North Hamlin Avenue, and on the north

#### side of West Fullerton Avenue, from North Hamlin Avenue to North Avers.
