### Resolution

WHEREAS, Florence Brady turns 101 on April 22, 2013; and,

WHEREAS, The City of Chicago City Council has been notified of her celebration by The Honorable Harry Osterman, Alderman of the 48<sup>th</sup> Ward; and

WHEREAS, Florence Brady was born April 22, 1912, in the Oklahoma Panhandle just five years after the territory entered the Union. After obtaining her two-year teaching certificate, Florence taught in a one-room school, where her duties included firing up the wood'stove on cold winter mornings. Unusual for women in the early part of the 20<sup>th</sup> century, she went to college, eventually earning a master's degree in economics from the University of Oklahoma. She then married the late Walt Sellers. Mr. Sellers died when the pair's two girls were only seven and Florence became a single working mother. She married Mike Brady after several years and the two raised the twins together. The couple moved into the Admiral Retirement Community in December 1994 where Mr-Brady died suddenly three years later. Following a hiatus during the construction of the new building at 929 West Foster, Florence returned "home" in January 2013, where she enjoys "the good food, good bed,-and good conversation".
