ORDINANCE OLD TOWN
REFINERY Acct. No. 367757 - 1
Permit No. 1107996

Be It Ordained by the City Council of the City of Chicago:

Permission and authority are hereby given and granted to OLD TOWN REFINERY upon the terms and subject to the conditions of this ordinance, to maintain and use a portion of the public right of way for a sidewalk cafe adjacent to its premises located at 1209-1211 N. Wells St.. Said sidewalk cafe area #1 shall be forty-eight (48) feet in length and nine point eight three (9.83) feet in width, area #2 shall be twenty-nine point seven five (29.75) feet in length and nine point eight three (9.83) feet in width for a total of seven hundred sixty-four point two eight (764.28) square feet and shall allow six (6) feet of clear space from the face of the curb/building line along N Wells St. The compensation for said space and the days and hours of operation for the sidewalk cafe shall be as follows:

Monday thru Thursday 5:00 p.m. until 12:00 midnight
Friday 4:00 p.m. until 12:00 midnight
Saturday & Sunday 8:00 a.m. until 12:00 midnight
Compensation: \$1,757.85
SEATING CAPACITY: 60

Sidewalk Cafe Permit and approved plan must be posted at all times.

This grant of privilege #1107996 for a sidewalk cafe shall be subject to the provisions of Section 10-28-800 though 10-28-885 of the Municipal Code of Chicago and the directions of the Commissioner of Department of Business Affairs and Consumer Protection, the Commissioner of Streets and Sanitation, and the Commissioner of Transportation.

The permit holder agrees to hold the City of Chicago harmless for any damage, relocation or replacement costs associated with damage, relocation or removal of private property caused by the City performing work

in the public way.

Authority for the above named privilege is herein given and granted from and after March 1, 2013 through and including December 1, 2013.
