## TRAFFIC LANE - TOW/AWAY ZONE

# BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:

SECTION 1. Pursuant to Title 9, Chapter 64, of the Municipal Code of Chicago, the

following locations are hereby designated as traffic lane - Tow/Away Zones, between the

limits and during the times specified, standing or parking of any vehicle shall be considered a

definite hazard to the normal movement of traffic:

### WARD TOW AWAY ZONES:

3 S. Dearborn Street (both sides) from W. 17th Street to a point 125 feet north thereof; and W. 17th Street (both sides) from S. Clark Street to a point 50 feet east thereof; and W. 17th Street both sides from S. Dearborn Street to a point 50 feet west thereof: No Parking Tow Zone (13-01467376 & 13-01367493) [Or2013-528] SECTION 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force here in after its passage and publication.
