1 HOUR PARKING

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:

SECTION 1. That the Commissioner of Transportation is hereby authorized and directed to install 1 Hour Parking signs at the below listed locations:

WARD MISCELLENEOUS:

- 38 W. Montrose Avenue; Repeal ordinance passed 7/19/2000, journal page 38631, which reads: W. Montrose Avenue (south side) from a point 5 feet west of N. Parkside Avenue to a point 40 feet west thereof; One Hour Parking, 8:00am to 10:00pm, Sunday through Saturday, by striking the above - (13-01659532) [02013-680]

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force here in after its passage and publication.
