RESERVED (2% DISABLED) PARKING

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:

SECTION 1. That the Commissioner of Transportation is hereby authorized and directed to install Reserved Disabled Parking signs at the below listed locations:

WARD MISCELLENEOUS:

- 31 3006 N. Laramie Avenue; 2% Disabled Parking Zone, 7:00am to 6:00pm, Monday through Friday [02014-2299]
- 39 N. Pulaski Road (east side) from a point 190 feet north of W. Sunnyside Avenue to a point 20 feet north thereof; Reserved Disabled Parking, 9:00am to 6:00pm, Monday through Saturday - (14-00124719) [02013-6447]

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force here in after its passage and publication.
