**WARD AMEND TOW ZONE:**

13 W. 60th Street; Repeal No Parking Tow Zone, W. 60th Street from S. Knox Avenue to S. Keating Avenue. Request withdrawn by Alderman - (13-0874473) [O2013-5567]

**WARD TRAFFIC WARNING SIGNS AND/OR SIGNALS:**

2 W. Scott Street; All Way Stop Sign, W. Scott Street and N. Wells Street. Not recommended - (14-00398492) [Or2013-763]

14 S. Kedzie Avenue; All Way Stop Sign, S. Kedzie Avenue and W. 54th Street; CDOT does not recommend stop signs on major streets because they increase the frequency of rear-end-collisions, and divert traffic to local streets. Therefore CDOT does not support installing stops signs at S. Kedzie Avenue and W. 54th Street - (14-00463394) [Or2013-605]

14 S. Spaulding Avenue; All Way Stop Sign, S. Spaulding Avenue and W. 51st Street. Not Recommended on wide arterials such as W. 51st Street, could jeopardize pedestrian safety - (14-00463334) [Or2013-606]

14 S. Kedzie Avenue; All Way Stop Sign, S. Kedzie Avenue and W. 52nd Street. CDOT does not recommend stop signs on major streets because they increase the frequency of rear-end collisions, and divert traffic to local streets. Therefore CDOT does not support installing stops signs at S. Kedzie Avenue and W. 52nd Street --(14-00463726) [Or2013-607]

24 S. Kedzie Avenue; Two Way Stop Sign, S. Kedzie Avenue and W. 15th Street. CDOT does not recommend stop signs on major streets because they increase the frequency of rear-end collisions, and divert traffic to local streets - (14-00465223) [Or2013-617]

25 W. Washington Boulevard and S. May Street, All Way Stop Sign. Duplicate proposal, previously submitted on 9/11/13 (see Or2013-539) [Or2013-618]

These Do Not Pass recommendations were concurred in by all members of the Committee present, with no dissenting votes.
