SUBSTITUTE ORDINANCE

WHEREAS, the Annual Appropriation Ordinance for the year 2014 of the City of Chicago (the "City") contains estimates of revenues receivable as grants from agencies of the state and federal governments and public and private agencies; and

WHEREAS, the City through its Department of Police has been awarded federal grant funds in the amount of \$35,000 by the Chicago Housing Authority which shall be used for the Altgeld-Riverside Consortium Partnership; and

WHEREAS, the City through CDOT has been awarded additional state grant funds in the amount of \$3,263,000 by the Illinois Department of Transportation ("IDOT") which shall be used for the IDOT Funds Arterial Streets Program; and

WHEREAS, the City through CDOT has been awarded additional federal grant funds in the amount of \$8,000 by IDOT which shall be used for the Safe Routes to School Program; and

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:

SECTION 2. To the extent that any ordinance, resolution, rule, order or provision of the Municipal Code of Chicago, or part thereof, is in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance, the provisions of this ordinance shall control. If any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this ordinance shall be held invalid, the invalidity of such section, paragraph, clause or provision shall not affect any of the other provisions of this ordinance.
