SUBSTITUTE ORDINANCE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:

SECTION 1. Title 17 of the Municipal Code of the City of Chicago, the Chicago Zoning Ordinance, is hereby amended by removing the Pedestrian Street designation symbols and indications from that segment of the West Cermak Avenue right-of-way on Map Number 6-I in the area bounded by

the centerline of South California Avenue on the east and the centerline of South Marshall Boulevard on the west.

SECTION 2. Section 17-3-0503-D-2 of Title 17 of the Municipal Code of Chicago, the Chicago Zoning Ordinance, is hereby amended by deleting the stricken language and inserting the underscored language, as follows:

17-3-0503-D [Pedestrian Streets and Pedestrian Retail Streets.]
