ORDINANCE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:

SECTION 1. Section 13-12-340 of the Municipal Code of the City of Chicago is hereby amended by inserting the language underscored, as follows:

13-12-340 Re-examination.

a) Where a supervising electrician has not acted in the capacity of a supervising electrician in the city for a continuous period of three years, he shall be reexamined as provided for in section 13-12-230 before he shall be certified as a supervising electrician.

b) Where a supervising electrician has not obtained a permit from the department of buildings for a continuous period of three years he shall be required to take another examination as provided for in section 13-12-230 before he shall receive another permit.

(c) Nothing in this section shall apply to any supervising electrician whose failure to act in that capacity or to obtain a permit for electrical work for a period of three years is due to the supervising electrician's having been employed by the city of Chicago during the period of such inactivity: provided, however, that if the former employee does not reapply for a license as a supervising electrician within 60 days after separation from City employment shall be required to be reexamined for such license.

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
