INDUSTRIAL PERMIT PARKING ZONES

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:

SECTION 1. Pursuant to Title 9, Chapter 64, Section 090 of the Municipal Code of Chicago, portions of the below named streets are hereby designated as Industrial Permit Parking Zone Signs, for the following locations:

WARD INDUSTRIAL PERMIT PARKING ZONES:

40 5100 N. Ravenswood Avenue; 5101-5199 N. Ravenswood Avenue (east side) from the first street light southbound marked with a One Way Sign to the fourth street light southbound marked with a One Way Sign; And also, 5100-5198 N. Ravenswood Avenue (west side) from W. Foster Avenue to W. Winona Street; Industrial Permit Parking Zone 25, 8:00am to 10:00am, Monday through Saturday [Or2014-560]

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force here in after its passage and publication. CHICAGO, DECEMBER 10, 2014

To the President and Members of the City Council:
