SECTION 1. That the Commissioner of Transportation is hereby authorized and directed to establish and/or amend Two (2) Hour Parking Restriction Signs at the below listed locations:

WARD MISCELLEANEOUS:

- 45 N. Milwaukee Avenue; N. Milwaukee Avenue (west side) from W. Addison Street to N. Kenneth Avenue; Two Hour Parking, 9:00am to 6:00pm, Monday through Friday - (13-01868249) [02013-5417]
- 49 7461-7467 N. Marshfield Avenue; N. Marshfield Avenue (east side) from a point 10 feet south of N. Rogers Avenue to the first alley south thereof; Two Hour Parking, 8:00am to 6:00pm, All Days - (14-00427139) [02013-6500]
