ORDINANCE TJ MAXX #1404 Acct.
No. 21919-8 Permit No. 1113762

Be It Ordained by the City Council of the City of Chicago:

SECTION 1. Permission and authority are hereby given and granted to TJ MAXX #1404, upon the terms and subject to the conditions of this ordinance to maintain and use eight (8) sign(s) projecting over the public right-of-way attached to its premises known as 1008 S. Canal St..

Said sign structure(s) measures as follows; along S CANAL ST:

One (1) at fifteen point two five (15.25) feet in length, three point three three (3.33) feet in height and twenty-two (22) feet above grade level.

One (1) at twelve point two five (12.25) feet in length, two point six seven (2.67) feet in height and fifteen (15) feet above grade level.

One (1) at eighteen (18) feet in length, eight (8) feet in height and nine (9) feet above grade level. One (1) at eighteen (18) feet in length, eight (8) feet in height and twenty-eight (28) feet above grade level.

Two (2) at four point three three (4.33) feet in length, eight point eight three (8.83) feet in height and ten (10) feet above grade level.

One (1) at four point three three (4.33) feet in length, eight point eight three (8.83) feet in height and fifteen (15) feet above grade level.

One (1) at four point three three (4.33) feet in length, eight point eight three (8.83) feet in height and twenty (20) feet above grade level.

The location of said privilege shall be as shown on prints kept on file with the Department of Business Affairs and Consumer Protection and the Office of the City Clerk

Said privilege shall be constructed in accordance with plans and specifications approved by the Department of Transportation (Division of Project Development) and Zoning Department- Signs.

This grant of privilege in the public way shall be subject to the provisions of Section 10-28-015 and all other required provisions of the Municipal Code of Chicago.
