ORDINANCE

WHEREAS, the City of Chicago ("City") is a home rule unit of government by virtue of the provisions of the Constitution of the State of Illinois of 1970, and, as such, may exercise any power and perform any function pertaining to its government and affairs; and

WHEREAS, the City is the owner of the vacant parcel of property located at 1223 West 49th Place, Chicago, Illinois, which is legally described on Exhibit A attached hereto (the "Property"); and

WHEREAS, the Property was initially offered for sale under the Adjacent Neighbors Land Acquisition Program, as codified at Municipal Code Chapter 2-159-010 et seq. (the "ANLAP Program"), to the neighboring property owners at 1221 W. 49th Place and 1225 W. 49th Place; and

WHEREAS, after ordering the appraisal for the Property, the Department determined that the fair market value of the Property was less than the minimum ANLAP Program bid of \$1,000 and therefore decided to sell the Property via negotiated sale so that the Property could be sold for its fair market value; and

WHEREAS, Miguel Rico (the "Grantee"), of 1225 W. 49th Place, Chicago, Illinois 60609, offered to purchase the Property from the City for Six Hundred and No/100 Dollars (\$600), such amount being the appraised fair market value of the Property, to improve with landscaped open space thereon; and

WHEREAS, public notice advertising the City's intent to enter into a negotiated sale of the Property with the Grantee and requesting alternative proposals appeared in the Chicago Sun-Times, a newspaper of general circulation, on December 2 and December 9, 2014; and

WHEREAS, as the Property had been initially offered for sale under the ANLAP Program to the Grantee and Gilberto Ruiz, of 1221 W. 49th Place, the Department determined that Mr. Ruiz should receive direct notice of the sale and have an opportunity to purchase the Property; and

WHEREAS, the Department sent written notice via certified mail to both the Grantee and Mr. Ruiz, inviting both to bid on the Property and advising that the minimum acceptable bid would be Six Hundred and No/100 Dollars (\$600); and

WHEREAS, both the Grantee and Mr. Ruiz submitted bids to the Department; and

WHEREAS, the higher of the two bids was submitted by the Grantee in the amount of Seven Hundred and No/100 Dollars (\$700.00), to improve with landscaped open space thereon; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 15-003-21 adopted on January 15, 2015, by the Plan Commission of the City (the "Commission"), the Commission approved the negotiated sale of the Property to the Grantee; and

WHEREAS, public notice advertising the City's intent to enter into a negotiated sale of the Property with the Grantee and requesting alternative proposals appeared in the Chicago

Sun-Times, a newspaper of general circulation, on March 23 and March 30, 2015; and

WHEREAS, no alternative proposals were received by the deadline indicated in the aforesaid notice; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:

SECTION 1. The City Council of the City hereby approves the sale of the Property to the Grantee for the amount of Seven Hundred and No/100 Dollars (\$700.00).

SECTION 2. The Mayor or his proxy is authorized to execute, and the City Clerk or Deputy City Clerk is authorized to attest, a quitclaim deed conveying the Property to the Grantee. The quitclaim deed shall contain language substantially in the following form:

This conveyance is subject to the express condition that: the Property is improved with landscaped open space within six (6) months of the date of this deed. In the event that the condition is not met, the City of Chicago may re-enter the Property and revest title in the City of Chicago. Grantee, at the request of the City of Chicago, covenants to execute and deliver to the City a reconveyance deed to the Property to further evidence such revesting of title.

SECTION 3. If any provision of this ordinance shall be held to be invalid or unenforceable for any reason, the invalidity or unenforceability of such provision shall not affect any of the other provisions of this ordinance.

SECTION 4. All ordinances, resolutions, motions or orders inconsistent with this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

SECTION 5. This ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and approval.
