TRAFFIC WARNING SIGN AND/OR SIGNALS

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:

SECTION 1. Pursuant to Title 9, Chapter 64, of the Municipal Code of Chicago, that the Commissioner of Transportation is hereby authorized and directed to erect and/or amend Traffic Warning Signs and Signals, for the following locations are hereby designated:

WARD TRAFFIC WARNING SIGNS AND/OR SIGNALS:

- 27 100 N. Green Street; 100 N. Green Street and W. Washington Street; All Way Stop Sign, Stopping All Approaches [Or2015-260]
- 31 3017 and 3036 N. Lockwood Avenue; N. Lockwood Avenue and W. Nelson Street; Stop Sign [Or2015-261]
- 31 2900 N. Central Avenue; N. Central Avenue and W. George Street; Stop Sign [Or2015-262]
- 39 N. Kimball Avenue; N. Kimball Avenue and W. Catalpa Avenue; Two Way Stop Signs, Stopping north and southbound traffic on N. Kimball Avenue at W. Catalpa Avenue [Or2015-87]
- 39 N. Hiawatha Avenue; N. Hiawatha Avenue at N. Forest Glen Avenue; Stop Sign [Or2015-90]
- 39 W. Thome Avenue; W. Thome Avenue at N. Kirkwood Avenue; Stop Sign [Or2015-239]

**SECTION 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force here in after its passage and publication.
