Ohio Street to a point 224 feet north thereof: No Parking Tow Zone, 7:00am to 4:00pm. School

19 S. Sacramento Avenue; S. Sacramento Avenue (west side) from a point 20 feet north

of W. 108th Street to a point 55 feet north thereof; Official School Personnel Permit Parking
