### INDUSTRIAL PERMIT PARKING

#### BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:

**SECTION 1. Pursuant to Title 9, Chapter 64, Section 090 of the Municipal Code of Chicago, portions of the below named streets are hereby designated as Industrial Permit Parking Zones, for the following locations:**

#### WARD AMEND INDUSTRIAL PERMIT PARKING:

47 N. Ravenswood Avenue; Amend Industrial Permit Parking Zone Ordinance which reads: N. Ravenswood Avenue (east roadway, both sides) from W. Wilson Avenue to W. Leland Avenue; Industrial Permit Parking Zone 22, 7:00am to 8:00pm, Monday through Friday by striking the above and inserting in lieu thereof: N. Ravenswood Avenue (east roadway, both sides) from W. Wilson Avenue to W. Leland Avenue; Industrial Permit Parking Zone 20, 7:00am to 8:00pm, Monday through Friday [02015-6326]
