COMMERCIAL ORDINANCE

WHEREAS, the City of Chicago ("City") is a home rule unit of local government pursuant to Article VII, Section 6 (a) ofthe 1970 constitution of the State of Illinois and, as such, may exercise any power and perform any function pertaining to its government and affairs; and

WHEREAS, the properties at 1209-1217 W. Carroll Avenue and 1208-1216 W. Fulton Market Street are owned by Fulton/Racine Property LLC, an Illinois Limited Liability Company; and

WHEREAS, Fulton/Racine Property LLC proposes to use the portion of the alley to be vacated herein for employee parking; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Chicago, after due investigation and consideration, has determined that the nature and extent of the public use and the public interest to be subserved is such as to warrant the vacation of part of public alley, described in the following ordinance; now therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:

SECTION 1. THAT PART OF THE EAST-WEST 18-FOOT WIDE PUBLIC ALLEY LYING SOUTH OF AND ADJOINING THE SOUTH LINE OF LOTS 1,2,3 AND 4 AND LYING NORTH OF AND ADJOINING THE NORTH LINE OF LOTS 29, 30,31 AND 32, ALL IN BLOCK 3 IN MAGIE AND HIGH'S ADDITION TO CHICAGO IN THE SOUTHWEST ¹A OF SECTION 8, TOWNSHIP 39 NORTH, RANGE 14, EAST OF THE THIRD PRINCIPAL MERIDIAN, RECORDED OCTOBER 24, 1855 (ANTE-FIRE), IN COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS. TOTAL LAND AREA = 1,802 SQ. FT. = 0.041 ACRE, MORE OR LESS as shaded and legally described by the words "HEREBY VACATED" on the plat hereto

attached as Exhibit A, which drawing for greater clarity, is hereby made a part of this ordinance, be and the same is hereby vacated and closed, inasmuch as the same is no longer required for public use and the public interest will be subserved by such vacation.

SECTION 2. The City of Chicago hereby reserves for the benefit of Commonwealth Edison, AT&T/SBC, Comcast and their successors or assigns, a non-exclusive utility easement to operate, maintain, construct, replace and renew overhead wires, poles, and associated equipment and underground conduit, cables, and associated equipment forthe transmission and distribution of electrical energy, telephonic and associated services under, over and along the alley herein vacated, with the right of ingress and egress. The grade of the vacated public way shall not be altered in a manner so as to interfere with the operation and maintenance of Commonwealth Edison, AT&T/SBC, and/or Comcast facilities. No buildings, permanent structures or obstructions shall be placed over Commonwealth Edison, AT&T/SBC and/or Comcast facilities without express written release of the involved utility. Any future vacation-beneficiary prompted relocation of the aforementioned facilities lying within the area being vacated will be accomplished by involved utility and done at the expense of beneficiary of the vacation.

SECTION 3. The vacation herein provided for is made upon the express condition that within 180 days after the passage of this ordinance, Fulton/Racine Property LLC shall pay or cause to be paid to the City of Chicago as compensation for the benefits which will accrue to the owner of the property abutting said part of public alley hereby vacated the sum

which sum in the judgment of this body will be equal to such benefits.

SECTION 4. The vacation herein provided for is made upon the express condition that within one hundred eighty (180) days after the passage of this ordinance, shall file or cause to be filed for record in the Office of the Recorder of Deeds of Cook County, Illinois a certified copy of this ordinance, together with an attached plat as approved by the Superintendent of Maps and Plats.

SECTION 5. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage. The vacation shall take effect and be in force from and after its recording.
