INDUSTRIAL PERMIT PARKING

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:

SECTION 1. Pursuant to Title 9, Chapter 64, Section 090 of the Municipal Code of Chicago, portions of the below named streets are hereby designated as Industrial Permit Parking Zones, for the following locations:

WARD INDUSTRIAL PERMIT PARKING:

14 South Kildare Avenue; South Kildare Avenue (east side of street) from 4501 South

Kildare Avenue to W. 45th Street, and wrapping around onto the south side of West 45th Street to South Tripp Avenue; Industrial Permit Parking Zone, 6:00am to 6:00pm, Monday through

Friday [Or2015-566]

This ordinance shall take effect and be in force here in after its passage CHICAGO, OCTOBER 14, 2015
