ORDINANCE
UNIVERSITY OF CHGO FILE #30 Acct. No
43697 - 14 Permit No 1118284

Be It Ordained by the City Council of the City of Chicago:

SECTION 1. Permission and authority are hereby given and granted to UNIVERSITY OF CHGO FILE #30, upon the terms and subject to the conditions of this ordinance to maintain and use, as now constructed, Steam service pipes consisting of one (1) six (6) inch high pressure steam main one (1) three (3) inch high pressure drip main beginning at an existing steam service manhole located under the sidewalk on the west side of the south curb line of east 60 Street, thence running south under sidewalk entering a manhole, the south of wall of said manhole is at appoint approximately one hundred ninety-six (196) feet, south of south curb line of East 60th StreetLines(s) under the public right-of-way adjacent to its premises known as 6000 S. Ingleside Ave..

Said Steam Lines(s) at S. Ingleside Avenue measure(s):

One (1) at one hundred ninety-six point five (196.5) feet in length, and one (1) foot in width for a total of one hundred ninety-six point five (196.5) square feet.

The location of said privilege shall be as shown on prints kept on file with the Department of Business Affairs and Consumer Protection and the Office of the City Clerk.

Said privilege shall be constructed in accordance with plans and specifications approved by the Department of Transportation (Office of Underground Coordination) and Department of Water Management.

This grant of privilege in the public way shall be subject to the provisions of Section 10-28-015 and all other required provisions of the Municipal Code of Chicago.

The grantee shall pay to the City of Chicago as compensation for the privilege #1118284 herein granted the sum of four hundred (\$400.00) per annum in advance.

A 25% penalty will be added for payments received after due date.

The permit holder agrees to hold the City of Chicago harmless for any damage, relocation or replacement costs

associated with damage, relocation or removal of private property caused by the City performing work in the public way.

Authority herein given and granted for a period of five (5) years>from and after 11/28/2014.
