### TWO HOUR PARKING

### BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:

**SECTION 1.** That the Commissioner of Transportation is hereby authorized and directed to establish and/or amend Two Hour Parking Restriction Signs at the below listed locations:

### WARD MISCELLEANEOUS:

- 1 West Wabansia Avenue; West Wabansia Avenue (north side) from a point 30 feet east of North Richmond Street to a point 90 feet east thereof; Two Hour Parking, 9:00am to 3:00pm, Sundays and 6:30pm to 9:30pm, Thursdays [02015-7781]
- 1 West Wabansia Avenue; West Wabansia Avenue (south side) from a point 30 feet east of North Richmond Street to a point 76 feet east thereof; Two Hour Parking, 9:00am to 3:00pm, Sundays and 6:30pm to 9:30pm, Thursdays [02015-7782]

**SECTION 2.** This ordinance shall take effect and be in force here in after its passage and publication.
