46	4700-4799 North Clark Street; 4700-4799 North Clark Street (east and west sides); Parking Meters [02015-7847]

## WARD AMEND PARKING METERS:

North Halsted Street; North Halsted Street (west side) from West Wellington Avenue to West Oakdale Avenue; Repeal Parking Meters [02015-796]
