ORDINANCE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:

SECTION 1. The City Council finds that the areas described in Sections 2 and 3 of this ordinance are adversely affected by the over-concentration of businesses licensed to sell alcoholic liquor within and near the areas.

SECTION 2. Section 4-60-022 of the Municipal Code of Chicago is hereby amended by inserting the underscored language and deleting the language struck through, as follows:

4-60-022 Restrictions on additional licenses.

Subject to the provisions of subsection 4-60-021 (c), no additional license shall be issued for the sale of alcoholic liquor, for consumption on the premises within the following areas:

(3.58) On 47 Street, from Michigan Avenue to Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. Drive, and on Dr. Martin Luther King Drive, from 47th Street to 46th Street.

SECTION 3. Section 4-60-023 of the Municipal Code of Chicago is hereby amended by inserting the underscored language and deleting the language struck through, as follows:

4-60-023 Restrictions on additional package goods licenses.

Subject to the provisions of subsection 4-60-021 (c), no additional package goods license shall be issued for

any premises located within the following areas:

(3.62) On 47 Street, from Michigan Avenue to Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. Drive, and on Dr. Martin Luther King Drive, from 47th Street to 46th Street.
