WEIGHT LIMITATIONS

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:

SECTION 1. Pursuant to Title 9, Chapter 64, Section 030 of the Municipal Code of Chicago, the Maximum Weight Permitted to be carried by any truck or commercial vehicle upon the following public ways between the limits indicated except for the purpose of delivering or picking up material or merchandise shall be as follows:

WARD WEIGHT LIMITATIONS:

30 3200 West Keating Avenue; North Keating Avenue from West School Street to West

Belmont Avenue; Weight Limitations 5 - Tons - (15-0667619) [02015-8391]

WARD AMEND WEIGHT LIMITATIONS:

39 North Kostner Avenue; Repeal Ordinance Passed 12/30/1960, journal page 4197,

which reads: North Kostner Avenue from West Irving Park Road to West Montrose

Avenue; Weight Limitations 5 - Tons, by Striking the above [02016-570]

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force here in after its passage and publication.
