### ORDINANCE

#### BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:

SECTION 1. Section 2-74-020 of the Municipal Code of the City of Chicago is hereby amended by deleting the struck-through language, as follows:

#### **2-74-020 Department established - Composition - Commissioner's powers and duties.**

There is hereby established an executive department of the City of Chicago which shall be known as the department of human resources.

(8)(a) Impose a fee for the preparation, administration and processing of examinations relating to entry level positions in the city service. The maximum examination fee relating to each entry level examination shall be as follows:

~~Police officer \$30.00~~

~~Uniformed service in fire department 30.00~~

Professional series (multiple positions) 10.00

Other 5.00

~~The commissioner may provide by rule for a waiver of the examination fee relating to entry level~~
