ORDINANCE

CHICAGO PUBLIC LIBRARY WOODSON REGIONAL Acct. No.

33118 -6 Permit No. 1123298

Be It Ordained by the City Council of the City of Chicago:

SECTION 1. Permission and authority are hereby given and granted to CHICAGO PUBLIC LIBRARY WOODSON REGIONAL, upon the terms and subject to the conditions of this ordinance to construct, install, maintain and use two (2) Sun Shades projecting over the public right-of-way adjacent to its premises known as 9525 S. Halsted St..

Said Sun Shade at S. Halsted Street measure(s):

One (1) at forty-two point three three (42.33) feet in length, and five (5) feet in width for a total of two hundred eleven point six five (211.65) square feet. Said sun shade shall be approximately twenty-seven (27) feet above grade level.

Said Sunscreen(s) at W. 95th Street measure(s):

One (1) at eighteen (18) feet in length, and two point eight three (2.83) feet in width for a total of fifty point nine four (50.94) square feet. Said sun shade shall be approximately twenty-six (26) feet nine (9) inches above grade level.

The location of said privilege shall be as shown on prints kept on file with the Department of Business Affairs and Consumer Protection and the Office of the City Clerk

Said privilege shall be constructed in accordance with plans and specifications approved by the Department of Transportation (Division of Project Development).

This grant of privilege in the public way shall be subject to the provisions of Section 10-28-015 and all other required provisions of the Municipal Code of Chicago.

The grantee shall pay to the City of Chicago as compensation for the privilege #1123298 herein granted the sum of one hundred thirteen (\$113.00) per annum in advance.

A 25% penalty will be added for payments received after due date.
