**SECTION 1. That the Commissioner of Transportation is hereby authorized and directed to install and/or amend Reserved Parking (2% Disabled) Signs at the below listed locations:**

### WARD MISCELLEANEOUS:

- 10            3009 East 92nd Street; East 92nd Street (south side) from a point 100 feet east of South Commercial Avenue to a point 20 feet east thereof; Reserved Parking (2% Disabled), 8:00am to 8:00pm, Monday through Saturday - (15-01864246) [Or2015-168]
  
- 50            3312 West Peterson Avenue; West Peterson Avenue (north side) from a point 131 feet east of North Christiana Avenue to a point 20 feet east thereof; Reserve Parking (2% Disabled), 9:00am to 4:00pm, Monday through Friday, Public Benefit - (16-03430180) [02016-3000]
