TRAFFIC LANE - TOW ZONES

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:

SECTION 1. Pursuant to Title 9, Chapter 64, of the Municipal Code of Chicago, the following locations are hereby designated as Traffic Lane - Tow Zones, between the limits and during the times specified, standing or parking of any vehicle shall be considered a definite hazard to the normal movement of traffic:

WARD TOW ZONES:

- 25 2200 South Loomis Street; 2200 South Loomis Street to the Bridge; No Parking Tow Zone, All Times, All Days [02016-5420]
- 32 West Webster Avenue; West Webster Avenue (south side) from North Elston Avenue to North Wood Street; No Parking Tow Zone, All Times, All Days - (16-03816356) [02016-5445]

WARD AMEND TOW ZONES:

- 13 South Lamont Avenue; Amend Ordinance Passed 03/12/2008 journal page 22815, which reads: South Lamont Avenue (east and west sides) from west 63rd Street to the ■ first alley south thereof; No Parking Tow Zone, 7:00am to 10:00pm, All Days, by Striking: 10:00pm and All Days and inserting in lieu thereof: 10:00am, Monday through Friday - (15-05520468) [02015-7164]
- 36 North Austin Avenue; Repeal Ordinance Passed 09/26/1956 journal page 3294, which

reads: North Austin Avenue (west side) from a point 20 feet north of West Eddy Street to a point 115 feet north thereof; by Striking the above - (16-03399381) [02016-3317]

- 36 North Austin Avenue; Repeal Ordinance Passed 02/25/1970, journal page 7964-65, which reads: North Austin Avenue (east side) from West Eddy Street to the first alley north thereof; No Parking Tow Zone, by Striking the above -- (16-03399620) [02016-3322]
- 36 North Austin Avenue; Repeal Ordinance Passed 01/17/1969, journal page 4897, which reads: North Austin Avenue (east and west sides) from West Eddy Street to West Cornelia Avenue; No Parking Tow Zone, by Striking the above, And Also: Repeal Ordinance Passed 05/25/1948, journal page 2407, which reads: North Austin Avenue (east side) between West Cornelia Avenue and alley south; No Parking Tow Zone, by Striking the above -- (16-034033118) [02016-3323]
- 36 North Austin Avenue; Repeal Ordinance Passed 06/22/1976, journal page 3282, which reads: North Austin Avenue (east side) from West Roscoe Street to West Newport Street; No Parking Tow Zone, by Striking the above - (16-03403223) [02016-3326]

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force here in after its passage and publication.
