ORDINANCE

UNIVERSITY OF CHICAGO Acct. No.

43697 - 53 Permit No. 1124825

Be It Ordained by the City Council of the City of Chicago:

SECTION 1. Permission and authority are hereby given and granted to UNIVERSITY OF CHICAGO, upon the terms and subject to the conditions of this ordinance to maintain and use, as now constructed, two (2) Pipe(s) under the public right-of-way adjacent to its premises known as 1300-1314 E. 61st St..

Said Pipe(s) at 1300-1314 E. 61 STREET measure(s):

One (1) at one hundred forty (140) feet in length, and one (1) foot in width for a total of one hundred forty (140) square feet. Existing pipe is approximately ten (10) feet below grade level.

Said Pipe(s) at E. 61 ST STREET measure(s):

One (1) at sixty-six (66) feet in length, and one (1) foot in width for a total of sixty-six (66) square feet. Existing pipe is approximately ten (10) feet below grade level.

The location of said privilege shall be as shown on prints kept on file with the Department of Business Affairs and Consumer Protection and the Office of the City Clerk.

Said privilege shall be constructed in accordance with plans and specifications approved by the Department of Transportation (Office of Underground Coordination) and Department of Water Management.

This grant of privilege in the public way shall be subject to the provisions of Section 10-28-015 and all other required provisions of the Municipal Code of Chicago.

The grantee shall pay to the City of Chicago as compensation for the privilege #1124825 herein granted the sum of eight hundred (\$800.00) per annum in advance.

A 25% penalty will be added for payments received after due date.

The permit holder agrees to hold the City of Chicago harmless for any damage, relocation or replacement costs

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associated with damage, relocation or removal of private property caused by the City performing work in the public way.

Authority herein given and granted for a period of five (5) years from and after 10/04/2016.
