NOTE: These attachments to poles solely owned by poles shall be flush mounted and affixed with a through bolt type attaching device, the through bolt may not be more than 1/4" from the pole as to avoid injury to these workers climbing the pole to install the attachments. The licensee reserves the right to deny the use of any type of bracket proposed by the licensee to support its equipment.

2. The licensee shall coordinate and arrange such with joint owner if licensee elects to have service set on joint owner facilities performed. Licensee shall do so upon written request to joint owner (if applicable) extensions and work supply shall not be installed onto poles with static wire. Attachments onto existing fiberglass pole top or onto poles were they present an unusual climbing hazard.

4. Licensee shall always install its facilities on the same side of the pole as the coated neutral conductor and joint owners facilities. Licensee shall always install its facilities on the same side as other existing communications (if applicable) separate permit) etc shall be covered and secured with appropriate guard protector (fiber design by others under separate permit).
