ORDINANCE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:

SECTION 1. Chapter 9-80-190 of the Municipal Code of Chicago is hereby amended by inserting the language underscored and deleting the language struck through as follows:

9-80-190-Mobile food vendors and peddlers prohibited in modical center district.

No person shall conduct the business of a mobile food vendor or peddler as defined in this Code , on any portion of the public way within the boundaries of the medical center district and no person shall operate, stop or park any vehicle on any portion of the public way within the medical center district for the purposes of conducting any such businesses.

For the purpose of this section, "medical center district" means the area bounded by Ashland Avenue on the east, Congress Parkway on the north, Oakley Street on the west, and a line co-incidental with the north line of the property at or near 14th Street and 15th Street, owned or used by the Baltimore and Ohio Chicago Terminal Railroad Company for railroad purposes, on the south-Any person who violates the provisions of this section shall be fined not less than \$50.00 nor more than \$500.00 for each offense
