ORDINANCE U-STOR-IT  
Acct. No. 405774 - 1 Permit  
No. 1124489

*Be It Ordained by the City Council of the City of Chicago:*

SECTION 1. Permission and authority are hereby given and granted to U-STOR-IT, upon the terms and subject to the conditions of this ordinance to construct, install, maintain and use two (2) Foundation Support(s) (Footing) under the public right-of-way adjacent to its premises known as 1245 W. 15th St..

Said Foundation Support(s) (Footing) at W.15TH ST. measure(s):

One (1) at fifteen point five eight (15.58) feet in length, and one point two five (1.25) foot in width for a total of nineteen point four eight (19.48) square feet. Said footing shall be approximately twelve (12) feet three (3) inches below grade level.

Said Foundation Support(s) at S. THROOP ST. measure(s):

One (1) at twenty-one (21) feet in length, and one point two five (1.25) foot in width for a total of twenty-six point two five (26.25) square feet. Said footing shall be approximately twelve (12) feet three (3) inches below grade level.

The location of said privilege shall be as shown on prints kept on file with the Department of Business Affairs and Consumer Protection and the Office of the City Clerk.

Said privilege shall be constructed in accordance with plans and specifications approved by the Department of Planning and Development and Department of Transportation (Office of Underground Coordination).

This grant of privilege in the public way shall be subject to the provisions of Section 10-28-015 and all other required provisions of the Municipal Code of Chicago.

The grantee shall pay to the City of Chicago as compensation for the privilege #1124489 herein granted the sum of eight hundred (\$800.00) per annum in advance.

A 25% penalty will be added for payments received after due date.

The permit holder agrees to hold the City of Chicago harmless for any damage, relocation or replacement costs associated with damage, relocation or removal of private property caused by the City performing work in the public way. j/--
