BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:

SECTION 1. That the Commissioner of Transportation is hereby authorized and directed to install and/or amend Reserved Parking (2% Disabled) Signs at the below listed locations:

WARD

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40 40 MISCELLEANEOUS:

North Claremont Avenue; North Claremont Avenue (east side) from a point 93 feet north of 2310 West Ainslie Street to a point 25 feet north thereof; Reserved Parking (2% Disabled), All Times, All Days -- (17-00098837) [02016-8958]

6350 North Paulina Street; North Paulina Street (west side) from a point 20 feet north of West Highland Avenue to a point 20 feet north thereof; Reserved Parking (2% Disabled); All Times, All Days - (17-00071015) [02016-8962]

6348 North Ridge Boulevard; 6348 North Ridge Boulevard (west side) from a point 110 feet south of West Devon Avenue

to a point 40 feet south thereof; Reserved Parking (2% Disabled), All Times, All Days - (17-00098921) [02016-8993]
